

Middle & Senior School Alternative Block **Timetable WK 2 & 3 Term 2**

Structure of the day

• Sessions & Break Times

- There are 4 x 75 minute sessions per day;
 - 3 sessions before lunch are dedicated to explicit teaching & skill development time with subject teachers
 - 1 session after lunch is dedicated to supervised individual study, assignment/project work for students

Included in the 15 pre-lunch sessions

Middle School

- Year 7-12 will have a common session time for Extended Home Class Assembly/Chapel on Wednesday
- Year 7-9 will have one literacy/numeracy session per year level that is additional to their subjects

Senior School

• Year 10 will have 3 x sessions additional to subject lessons that have a literacy, numeracy and study focus. Students will be grouped in their core English/Mathematics classes for these sessions.

Individual study time expectations

Middle School

• Students in Year 7 to 9 are expected to complete activities and assessment tasks that they have been unable to finish within the block time allocated for their subjects. Students will be encouraged to create to do lists via their dashboard on SEQTA; reviewing and updating these daily.

Senior School

Year 10

• Students will be allocated 3 x sessions made up of literacy, numeracy and study that are additional to subject blocks in the weekly timetable

- When in blocks of independent study after lunch, students will be supervised in Home Class groups by a designated teacher.
- When a student in Year 10 has an allocated study line in their timetable, (due to VET, etc) this will appear as blank on the student timetable for Weeks 2 and 3. In this case, students are to go to the library to participate in these study sessions and will be supervised by library staff.

Year 11

- Students in Year 11 will not be allocated a classroom supervision after lunch for Session 4.
- Students will be supervised in the library for Session 4; should they choose to remain at school in the afternoon.
- In this time, students are expected to complete activities that they have been assigned as independent work or that they have been unable to finish within the block time allocated for their subjects. These sessions can also be used to work on revision for assessments and/or assignments.
- Subject teachers may encourage Year 11 students to remain on site during this time; however, parents/caregivers may wish for students to go home to complete independent study in Year 11.

Year 12

- Students in Year 12 will not be allocated a classroom supervision after lunch for Session 4.
- Students will be supervised in the library for Session 4; should they choose to remain at school in the afternoon.
- In this time, students are expected to complete activities that they have been assigned as independent work or that they have been unable to finish within the block time allocated for their subjects. These sessions can also be used to work on revision for assessments and/or assignments.
- Subject teachers may encourage Year 12 students to remain on site during this time; however, parents/caregivers may wish for students to go home to complete independent study in Year 12.
