

SA COVID-19 CLINICS

Metropolitan mobile and pop-up clinics (no referral or booking required, all ages)

- Adelaide - Victoria Park/Pakapakanthi, access via Wakefield Road (left-hand turn only) (8.00 am to 6.00 pm, 7 days). For cars and motorbikes only (no walk-ins or cyclists).
- Port Adelaide - Harts Mill Car Park, Mundy Street (8.30 am - 4.00 pm, 7 days). SA Pathology mobile testing vans. Capacity is limited.
