



# Information for Families

## COVID Testing, Isolating & Reporting Positive Student Case

If a student or teacher in your child's class tests positive for COVID-19, your child will be deemed a classroom contact and the following will occur:

- Schools will remain open, subject to SA Health advice, if there is a case of COVID-19 under the new arrangements.
- All parents of the cohort will be notified of the positive case via email.
- All students and children without symptoms can continue attending school. No rapid antigen testing will be required.
- If your child develops any symptoms (even mild) please keep them home from school, and get a COVID-19 test.
- Any student who has worked 1:1 with a COVID positive staff member (more than 15mins, indoors, in close proximity and where face masks are not able to be worn) will be asked to complete 7 days of rapid antigen testing ('test to stay') each morning before attending school. Students that test positive must not attend school.
- It is very important that parents notify us immediately if a child tests positive to COVID-19 via the link below. This is also found on our website under the COVID page.

### Confirmed Positive Case

To report a student positive COVID case to the College click on the COVID Notification Form  
Parents will be informed there has been a positive case of COVID-19 by the College if they shared a classroom or interacted with someone who has tested positive for COVID -19 (Teacher, SSO, ancillary staff or student)

### Classroom Contact

If a student or teacher in your child's cohort tests positive for COVID-19, they will be deemed a classroom contact and the following will occur:

- We will notify all parents in that class of the positive case via email
- All students without symptoms can continue attending school. No rapid antigen testing will be required.
- If your child develops any symptoms (even mild) please keep them home from school, and get a COVID-19 test.

### Student / SSO 1:1 Close Contact

Any student who has worked 1:1 with a COVID positive staff member (more than 15mins, indoors, in close proximity and where face masks are not able to be worn) will be asked to complete 7 days of rapid antigen testing ('test to stay') each morning before attending school. Students that test positive must not attend school.
