Dear parent/caregivers

Schools and preschools are an essential service. Public health advice from the senior experts around Australia remains that they can and should stay open.

We are adding new resources to the site every day, and it is freely available for all at [www.education.sa.gov.au/our-learning-sa](http://www.education.sa.gov.au/our-learning-sa).

The site includes a section which has videos and fact sheets focused on advice for families who are supervising their children's learning at home, including setting up a learning environment, staying happy and healthy while learning at home, reading at home with your child, preparing for online learning, and talking to your child about COVID-19.

Finally, as we approach the Easter break, I want to thank you for the role you are playing in our efforts to contain COVID-19. Everyone has a role to play, whatever their situation in life, and so far South Australia's community has been a global exemplar in doing what has needed to be done.

Best wishes for this school holiday period which promises to be unlike any we have experienced before. Hopefully it will be a time we can all remember in the years ahead as one where we found new and positive ways to support our families, friends and communities.
